

Celebrating Equinox

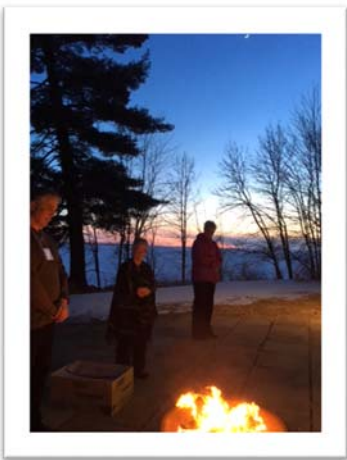
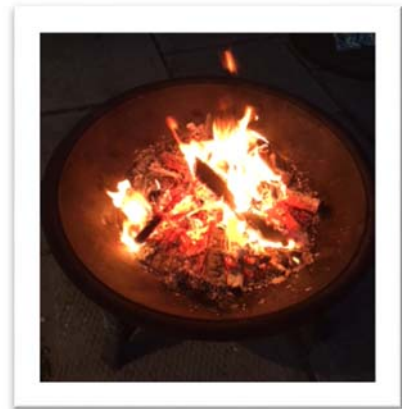
